If your acceptance is based on a 10-page abstract, then your full paper should be submitted to all members of the program committee, AND designated discussants, by **Friday**, **November 1**, **2019** (Japan time).

In the selection process, there is a possibility that priority will be given to young researchers/graduate students when choosing among papers of comparable quality.

Please also note that even when your paper is written/presented in English, we allow the audience to ask questions or make comments in Japanese (one of us will translate them for you, if necessary).

All the paper presenters, designated discussants and chairpersons will be provided with travel expenses. However, international travel expenses may not be fully covered.

We look forward to receiving many interesting submissions.
